Here's what's happening in Sumas over the next few months.

Utility Billing

Utility Disconnections for unpaid October utility bills will occur on November 12th, 2025 due to the holiday closure.

Sewer averages have ended for the year with this last billing cycle.

The next bill cycle (bills issued early December) will reflect sewer charges based on your actual water usage. This will continue each month through the March bill cycle.

This is a good time to keep a close eye on your water consumption. Often this is the time of year when water leaks are discovered, as high water usage will drastically affect your sewer charges, and the high water use due to a leak may have been missed during the summer months.

If you notice your water consumption has a sudden increase, you may have a water leak. Anything from leaking faucets, running toilets, and larger leaks can greatly affect your sewer bill.

Voyent Alert! And Winter Weather

Sumas uses the Voyent Alert! service to keep you informed during times of crisis and for day-to-day notices.

You can download the VoyentAlert! app, or register online to receive email, voice, or text based alerts at register.voyent-alert.us. Or call City Hall and we can sign you up for text alerts.

The City closely monitors the weather and Nooksack river gauges. We will only send Voyent Alert! notices related to weather or flooding when there is action that needs to be taken within our community.

Voyent Alert! is also used for road closures and utility related notices.
