

Protect Your Pipes! Cold Weather Alert – Prevent Frozen Pipes & Leaks

Colder temps are coming! Homes with exposed crawl spaces or walls under repair are at higher risk for frozen pipes. Take action now:

Simple Steps to Protect Your Home

- Keep your home heated, even if you're away
- Open cupboards under sinks to let warm air circulate
- Consider using approved heat tape for your type of piping
- Insulate exposed pipes if possible
- Safely keep areas where there are pipes warm if possible
- Place foam blocks in vents
- Cover outside faucets
- Disconnect hoses from the house
- Keep water dripping slightly only in sinks

Water Shut-Off Options

- If you would like your water shut-off before the colder temperature arrive, Call **City Hall** during business hours for water shut-off at the meter. 360-988-5711
- Drain lines by opening faucets once water is shut off
- Remember: **Only City staff** should turn water on/off at the meter
